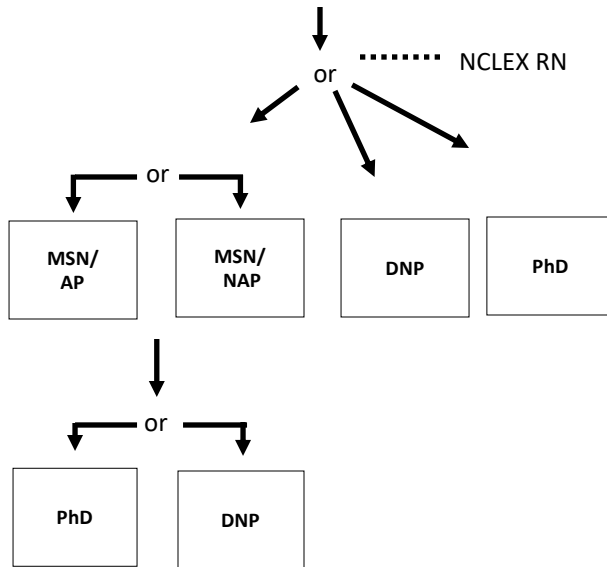


# Educational Pathways of Nursing

## Baccalaureate Degree (BSN) Registered Nursing (RN) (4 years including Pre-requisites)



**MSN** = Master's Degree in Nursing  
**DNP** = Doctorate in Nursing Practice  
**PhD** = Doctor of Philosophy in Nursing (Research)

### AP = Advanced Practice Roles \*

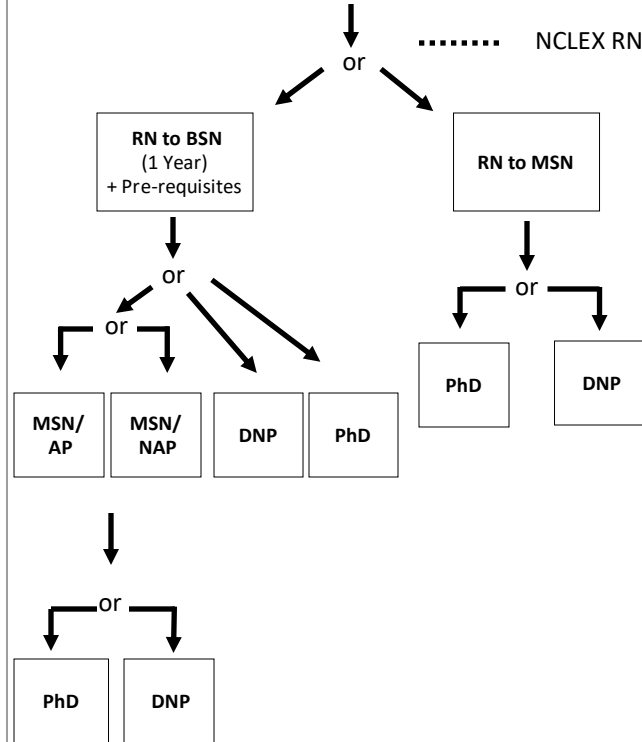
1. Nurse Practitioner
